## Moscow choir's 'terrific impact'

THE Male Voice Choir of the Moscow Synagogue enthralled the audience who turned out on a very wet Sunday evening to attend their performance at Mamlock House.

The 13 strong choir opened their powerful programme with "Haveinu Shalom Alechem", and unaccompanied throughout, their conductor, Alexander Tsalyuk, led them through a well chosen repertoire of Liturgical, Hebrew, Yiddish, and Russian melodies.

Cantor Boris Finklestein, of St. Petersburg Synagogue, and two young members of the choir, were soloists of the highest calibre and an added bonus was the contribution made by Chazan Mendel Feingeld, of Whitefield Synagogue.
